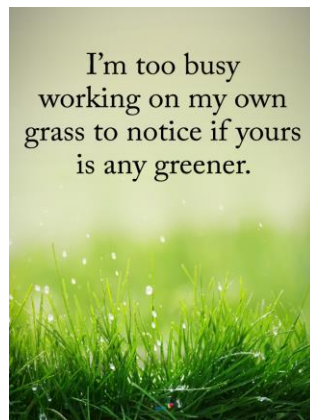
The Benefits of Spring Cleanup

Removal of wild trees and brush from areas that are difficult to reach or access.

Removing all low hanging tree limbs that make mowing difficult or not allowing the sunlight to reach the lawn causing the grass to die off.

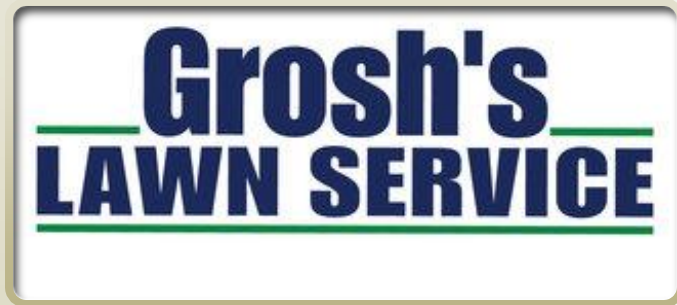
Visually and manually check all the landscaping beds to make sure there is the proper amount of mulch to last through the season.

Check bed edging as most edging diminishes over time and needs to be freshened up each season.
